MEMBERS AGES 16 – 17 / Parental Permission

Volunteer Member under the age of 18, please acknowledge the following rules and regulations:

- 1. Protecting Minors Ages 16 18
 - All Junior Members will be governed in accordance with Section 7.3(g) of the Child Labor Law, Bureau of Labor Law Compliance, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 - Junior Members cannot work a shift before 0700 hrs. or after 2200 hrs.
 - Junior members shall be permitted to work until 24:00 hrs. and begin at 06:00 hrs. during school vacation
 - Junior Members are not permitted to work more than (8) hours on a school day or (10) hours on a non-school day
- 2. Educational Requirements Ages 16 18
 - Junior Members MUST attend school to be involved with functions included but not limited to Training, EMS calls, and Events
 - Junior Members must submit a copy of their report card to the Volunteer Coordinator or their designee within 7 days of issue.
 - Failure to do so could result in restriction from all activities or shifts
 - Junior Members MUST maintain an overall "C" average in school. Those who have their grade average drop below a "C" average or have any "F", regardless of the overall average, could be restricted from participation in EMS activities.
 - A Junior Member may be reinstated when they receive a note from the instructor, on **School District Letterhead**, stating that the grade has risen to at least a "C"
 - Junior Members may be under restrictions if enrolled in summer school program for failure to pass subjects during the normal school year
