Description: This SOG establishes the stand-by procedures and rate for dedicated events.

Purpose: The intention of this guideline is to ensure members understand the procedures and actions for Stand-By Events and Compensation for Stand-By Events.

Procedure: Lower Providence EMS provides Stand-By EMS services to the community in various forms. LPEMS has designated rates of compensation and regulations governing these Events.

- 1. LPEMS Stand-By will be posted on the Duty Schedule.
 - a. It is the responsibility of the Stand-by Coordinator, Chief or their designee to post the schedule allowing for adequate notice of LPEMS Members/Crews.
- 2. In the event of a short notice event, the Stand-by Coordinator or Chief will contact the crew affected ASAP.
- 3. The Duty Crew is expected to attend any published stand-by unless the schedule has a dedicated crew assigned or is otherwise directed by the Chief.
- 4. Duty Crew assigned to an event will be based on the event's location.
 - a. 1st due unit will be responsible for coverage.
 - i. Unless otherwise directed by the Stand-by Coordinator or Chief.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the Duty Crew(s) to check the schedule for events during their shift.
- 6. Crew(s) assigned to an event will remain for the duration of the scheduled time.
 - a. If a crew must leave for an emergency call, the crew must return to the event immediately upon completion of the call.
- 7. Crew(s) dedicated for event coverage will be dedicated and will not respond to emergency calls.
 - a. If transport is needed from an event with a dedicated crew, the crew will immediately begin care and call for an additional unit to handle transport.
 - b. Stand-by crew will remain on site of the event.
 - i. Cases where it is in the best interest of the patient to immediately transport, the dedicated crew will transport.
 - 1. The next available LPEMS unit will relocate to the dedicated site and go unavailable on a special service until dedicated unit returns.
- 8. The uniform for events will be in accordance with LPEMS 101-018.

Dedicated Rate

- 1. The rate for dedicated Stand-by Paramedic is the individual OT Rate.
- 2. The current rate for dedicated Stand-by EMT is the individual OT Rate.
 - a. This rate is only appliable to Events posted and scheduled via W2W.
- 3. Current Rate for OPH COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic is Paramedic \$50 per hour EMT \$35 per hour.
